KEY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- Dr. Chidinma Ibe welcomed the group and introduced new members to the CAB.
- Dr. Ibe shared updates from community stakeholders and the Center for Health Equity faculty and staff (listed below).
- Dr. Ibe presented on the fundamentals of community-engaged research. Building on strengths in communities and facilitating collaborative partnerships were introduced as guiding principles of community engaged research.
- Dr. Ibe, Reverend Debra Hickman, and Mr. Leon Purnell participated in a panel led by Dr. Deidra Crews in which the panelists discussed their experiences with building collaborative partnerships in the context of community-based research.
- The panel discussion was followed by breakout sessions where the project leads from the three MACCHE studies provided an overview of their projects and solicited feedback from CAB members.
 - o In the **LINKED-HEARTS** breakout session, CAB members discussed using government programs to provide cellular services to low-income individuals both during and after the completion of the program. Others recommended offering low-cost broadband and internet connectivity to ensure access to the internet after study completion. To incentivize participation, CAB members also suggested allowing participants to keep cellular devices after the study is completed.  - o In the Healthy For Two (**H42**) breakout session, CAB members discussed partnering with local organizations such as B'More for Healthy Babies and the Judy Center to support mothers with social support and food assistance. CAB Members suggested including a wider variety of mothers represented in the welcome video and encouraged the team to mention this topic at upcoming Coordinating Council meetings.  - o In the **UNLOAD-HF** (heart failure) breakout session, CAB members recommended providing training opportunities for participants—particularly the elderly— to learn how to use their devices. They also recommended partnering with Comcast to allow participants to keep up with the exercise program if they miss a session.
